

## **Engineering Supervisor**

### **Course Aims**

The aim of the course is to provide delegates with the skills and underpinning knowledge required to undertake Engineering Supervisor duties in line with the Engineering Supervisor unit of competence.

### **Primary Objectives**

At the end of the training the delegate will be able to:

- Developed an understanding of what is required to be in charge of a work-site within a possession: to establish, maintain and give up work-sites and authorise the movement of trains into or within the work-site.

### **Duration**

Initial - 2 Days, 6 delegates max

Re-cert – 1 Days, 6 delegates max

### **Pre-Requisites**

#### **Delegates**

- Must be a minimum age of 18.
- Must hold a valid Sentinel Track Safety Card endorsed with PTS (not under learning support), and full IWA or COSS
- Meet the medical requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L2/OHS/00124 Competence Specific Fitness Medical Requirements
- Meet the requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L1/OHS/051 (Drugs & Alcohol)
- Have a good level of literacy to meet Entry Qualification
