Course Aims

This course is intended to provide a delegate with the understanding required to successfully interpret the relevant parts of the Network Rail Personal Track Safety Handbook when required to go on or the near line.

Primary Objectives

At the end of the training the delegate will be able to:

- Demonstrate their ability to interpret correctly the Rule Book GE/RT 8000 Series or Guide to Personal Track Safety or PTS key Point Card NR9922 and relevant local instructions when required to go on or near the line
- Demonstrate their understanding and ability to follow a Safe System of Work

Duration

One Day, 8 delegates max

Pre-Requisites

Delegates

- Must be a minimum age of 16
- Meet the medical requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L2/OHS/00124 Competence Specific Fitness Medical Requirements
- Make necessary arrangements for Knowledge Assessments to be read to support those who have difficulty with reading
- Meet the requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L1/OHS/051 (Drugs & Alcohol)
- Must have successfully completed the e-learning training and assessment prior to attendance
- Must have enough command of English language, and of the English language as detailed in Network Rail Company Specification NR/S/CTM/021 (Competence & Training in Track Safety)

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

For the initial course, the delegates are required to be near the running line, therefore, he/she MUST be in possession of: -

- Protective “all orange” high Visibility Clothing to BS EN 471:2003
- Safety Footwear to BS EN ISO 20345:2004
- Safety Helmet (blue) to BS EN 397:1995
- General Purpose Gloves to BS EN388:2121
- Safety Glasses to BS EN 166 and of Optical Class 1 with Impact Resistance F
