

Industry Common Induction (ICI)

This e-learning provides you with a health and safety induction for working in construction sites, rail depots and station maintenance. It has been developed by Network Rail, in partnership with ISLG (Infrastructure Safety Liaison Group) and RIAG (Rail Infrastructure Assurance Group). It covers the safety procedures and risks that are common across the rail industry, whatever your role and whatever type of site you are working at.

Once you feel confident that you understand the topics covered in this induction, please speak to your Sponsor or employer to book your Assessment. This will be conducted at an approved assessment centre. You must pass the Assessment in order to gain your ICI competence on Sentinel.

Step 1; Induction

This e-learning induction takes about one hour. It is organised in short sections, each one taking no more than 15-20 minutes to complete. We recommend that you work through the sections in the order they are shown. You do not have to study them all in one session. You can review each section (including the final 'Challenge') as many times as you wish.

You must ensure you view all the information in this e-learning - you may be tested on it at the Assessment Centre. Many screens need to be explored, by clicking on pictures, arrows or "More" buttons, in order to see all the information. When you have seen all information in a section, the main menu shows a tick by the section name to show you have completed it.

Step 2; Book your Final Assessment

Once you have completed the induction in Step 1 and are confident that you know the information covered, please speak to your Sponsor or employer to book your Final Assessment. This will be carried out at an approved assessment centre.

If you pass the Final Assessment, you will gain your ICI competence on your Sentinel card.

Step 3; Take the Final Assessment

- The final assessment must ONLY be undertaken at an invigilated assessment centre. If you fail to adhere to these guidelines you may be disqualified and not receive ICI competence.
